- Free Library Project Still pursuing a Community Foundation Grant. Books to be obtained through 'Novel Ideas.' Charlotte mentioned a budget in the \$5000 range for 10 Free Little Library kits.

New Business:

- Staley Pump House there is a group wanting to refurbish the pump house and save it from demolition. Alan and Mark met with members of that group and they indicated they have an 8 phase plan to re-purpose the pump house facility. There was a Motion made and approved by the Board "For the Corresponding Secretary to stipulate in an open letter, the Board's support of the effort to save the former Staley Pump House from demolition."
- There is going to be a Millikin Homestead Lawn Party on July 8, 2020 (July 9 rain date) need to determine what role Millikin Heights will participate.
- Beautification Committee Krista Foxx volunteered to head up this new committee. Potential
 synergies with the Beautify Decatur group, Adopt a Street program, large item pick-up, tree
 trimming opportunities were discussed.
