Old Business:

- 1. Little Free Library Project
 - There are two libraries in the ground; four others spoken for and an additional four available, although it is understood that Mark Peters is planning to take one.
 - There was a thought to possibly reach out to the Greenwood neighborhood as another location site.
 - Krista offered to take one of the undecorated libraries, and give hers to another interested party.
- 2. Neighborhood Revitalization
 - CHDO There is no update on the CHDO application at this time.
 - 124 N Edward St
 - House has been emptied; second (20 yd.) container moved out.
 - Mark Birch is getting quotes for siding, etc.
 - Jim discovered the backyard is heavily infiltrated with poison ivy. Charlotte indicated she could spray the problem area.
 - Krista raised the question about a landscaping budget and Alan suggested creating a landscape plan.
- 3. Beautification
 - Krista indicated that the previously planned Neighborhood Cleanup day would be moved to next spring.
 - A thought was discussed to have an award or type of recognition for homeowners who improve, or beautify, their property, including recognition on the Millikin Heights and/or NextDoor site.

Other Business -

• There is a group promoting and highlighting the history of the community called 'History of the Heartland' that is looking for affiliate partners. Alan suggested a motion "To approve Millikin Heights as an affiliate partner of the 'History of the Heartland' group." The motion was seconded and approved.
